
Paper Print of The Untamable Whiskers (George Méliès, 1903), <u>Library of Congress</u>







## FIAF (International Federation of Film Archives, 1938):

- British Film Institute (1933) founded by Royal Charter as the National Film Library
- Reichsfilmarchiv (1935) the state film archive of Nazi Germany
- Cinémathèque Française (1936) founded by Henri Langlois and Lotte Eisner
- Museum of Modern Art film archive (ca. 1935) led by curator Iris
  Barry after 1937





- 1969: IASA (International Association of Sound and Audiovisual Archives)
- 1977: FIAT (International Federation of Television Archives)
- 1980: Recommendation for the Safeguarding and Preservation of Moving Images (UNESCO)
- 1989: National Film Preservation Act (US)



- 1990: AMIA (Association of Moving Image Archivists)
- 1993: NFPB call for **post-graduate education** 
  - 1996: Selznick School of Preservation, George Eastman House
  - 2002: Moving Image Archival Studies, UCLA
  - 2003: Moving Image Archiving and Preservation, NYU
- 2000: National Recording Preservation Act (US)
