

## OER Textbook Creative Commons Image Info

One issue that I want to alert you to on the codes for our project is the **SA attribute**. This means "share alike." Any source with an SA designation can only populate sources with the same attributes. The Brooks book has the following designations: CC, BY, NC; they mean "creative commons, attribute the original author (BY), non-commercial (NC).

1. As I think we discussed previously, the textbook you are adapting has a CC BY-NC-SA license, and that last "SA" part means that your adaption will also need to carry this same license. If you look at the CC BY-NC-SA on the y-axis of this [compatibility chart](#), you'll see all of the licenses on the x-axis that are compatible with your license. The licenses compatible with the primary text being remixed are: PD, CC0, CC BY, CC BY NC, CC BY NC SA.

- i. So as an addendum to your first question, and with the above in mind, what did stand out to Caroline and I in your matrix are the content with the license CC BY-SA, which as you can see on that chart are not compatible with your license. The "Share-Alike" feature can be really tricky, and still confuses me as well! The content marked CC BY-SA cannot be adapted under a CC BY-NC-SA license because that would be changing the terms on the license, which is what the "SA" is meant to prevent. However, how you evaluate this also depends on if the content is stand-alone within a collection or included within the adaptation of the content.

We can use licenses: PD, CC0, CC BY, CC BY NC, CC BY NC SA.
